Degree Requirements:

- Students must have at least a 21 on the ACT **or** at least 750 on the GRE (prior to Oct. 2002, a score of 1200 is needed).
- Students must successfully complete the Praxis II exam in their areas of specialization before being recommended for teacher certification. A passing score on the Praxis II can be substituted for undergraduate course deficiencies (Praxis II passing scores: English -157, Science -139, Social Science -149, Math - 148)
- Students must successfully pass the Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) Exam before being recommended for teacher certification. (PLT must be passed before a student is eligible to participate in KTIP.)
- To be unconditionally admitted, students must meet all admission requirements, as well as passing the Praxis II content area speciality test(s).
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required for graduate study. No credit is allowed for final grades below "C".
- No course over 10 years old may be counted in this program.
- Candidates for a master's degree must file an application for their degree no later than the beginning of the semester during which they plan to complete their requirements.
- Course taken at the 500 level for undergraduate degrees may not be retaken or counted in this program.
- Any course substitutions must be approved in advance by advisor.
