You do not have to complete a major, minor, or area of concentration for the Bachelor of University Studies degree. You may take a wide variety of subjects or concentrate all studies beyond the general education requirements in a single discipline. ## You will receive your Bachelor of University Studies degree after you:

1. Complete a minimum of 128 semester hours of prescribed and elective college credit, 43 semester hours of which must be courses numbered 300 or above.
2. Earn a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 on all work completed at the University
3. Complete at least 32 hours at Morehead State University, with the last 16 hours preceding graduation earned from MSU. Correspondence courses do not satisfy this requirement.
4. Complete 49 semester hours of general education courses:
