

Morehead State University has been offering classes in Mt. Sterling since 1978. This tradition was enhanced and expanded through the help of legislators, the school system and business and industry leaders when the Clay Community Center was built. Owned and operated by Montgomery CommUNITY Development, INC, this \$5.5 million facility opened for classes in August 2003. In 2005 through further community efforts an additional \$1.5million was obtained for an expansion of MSU's portion of the Clay Community Center.

Associate Degree In Nursing (ADN)



The Associate Degree Nursing Program (ADNP) is a two-year program of study leading to an Associate of Applied Sciences (AAS) degree with an area of concentration in nursing. The program combines general education studies with nursing theory and clinical education. The Program is designed to prepare graduates for the role of the Registered Nurse (RN). Graduates of the Program are eligible to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses. The ADNP is accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission, Inc., 61 Broadway, New York, NY 10006. Bachelor of Business (BBA), General Business

The demand for general business professionals encompasses both public and private sectors and all industries. Bachelor of Social Work (BSW)

Social work graduates work in health care, hospice, mental health, mental retardation, child welfare, rehabilitation, school systems, services to families and children, domestic violence prevention, services to the homeless, and substance abuse prevention and treatment.
