

KCTCS Completer Degree – Bachelor of University Studies

Program Description: This degree is designed to allow students with AA/AS or AAS degrees from KCTCS to earn a baccalaureate degree at Morehead State University by completing 128 semester hours. Students must complete 43 semester hours at the 300 level or above and 32 semester hours from Morehead State University as well as earn a minimum GPA of 2.00. Students who have earned an AAS degree from KCTCS and do not want to enter into a Morehead State University baccalaureate program that has an articulated degree transfer program agreement between MSU and KCTCS such as BSN, BS in Radiologic Science, BS in Industrial Technology, BA in Teacher Education, etc... AAS students wanting to pursue the BUS degree will be required to declare the BUS degree upon transfer to Morehead State University. If the BUS degree is not declared at the time of transfer, some of the credits from the technical programs may not be awarded credit toward another MSU degree unless they are part of an articulation degree transfer program between KCTCS and MSU.
