Program Description: Social work is a human service profession that assists the needs of society in several areas, including gerontology, health care, mental retardation, child welfare, correctional rehabilitation, mental health, income maintenance, home health, hospice, domestic violence, homelessness, and alcoholism/substance abuse. The BSW Program is fully accredited by the Council on Social Work Education and prepares students as generalist practitioners or entry-level professional practice with individuals, marital couples, families, small groups, organizations, practitioners, and entire communities. The BSW Program has a selective admission procedure. Enrollment in the program is limited. In the event there are more qualified applicants than available positions, the top qualified 30- 35 students will be admitted for the fall and spring semesters.
