

MAJOR JAMES SCOTT DEHART GRADUATE FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION

Criteria:

- Must be from Rowan County. The order for consideration will be: 1st high school graduate, 2nd native, and 3rd current resident.
- If there is not an eligible student from Rowan County, preference will be given to a student from one of the counties contiguous to Rowan. (Bath, Carter, Fleming, Lewis, Meniffee or Morgan)

Conditions:

- The fellowship is available for one year.
- The recipient shall be eligible for renewal of the fellowship for one additional year if satisfactory academic progress is maintained. The student must re-apply.
- Students must be enrolled full-time for a graduate degree program. (nine hours in 500-600 level courses)
- A recipient who fails to maintain a 3.0 g.p.a. shall be terminated automatically at the end of the semester.
- The fellowship will rotate bi-annually among MSU's four colleges beginning with the College of Science & Technology. (Order of rotation: College of Business, College of Education, Caudill College of Humanities) If there is not a qualified student from the College of Science & Technology then the fellowship will rotate to the next college.
- The recipient is to be selected by the MSU Graduate Committee.
- The deadline for admission and application completion is August 1.
