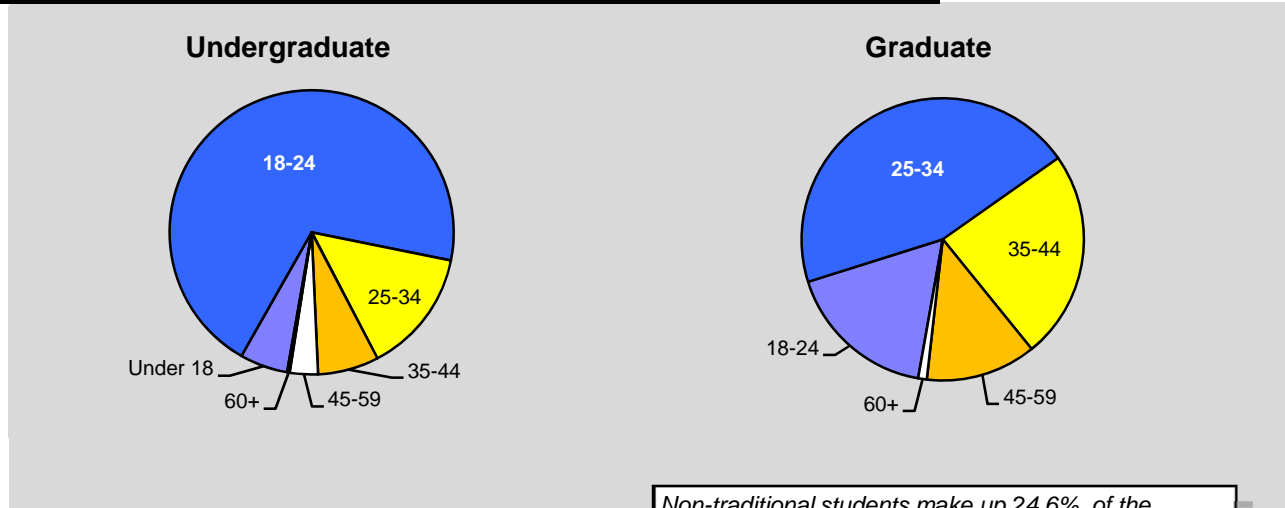


## Enrollment by Level, Age, and Sex Fall 2007

*Non-traditional students make up 24.6% of the undergraduate population (1,875 of 7,619)*

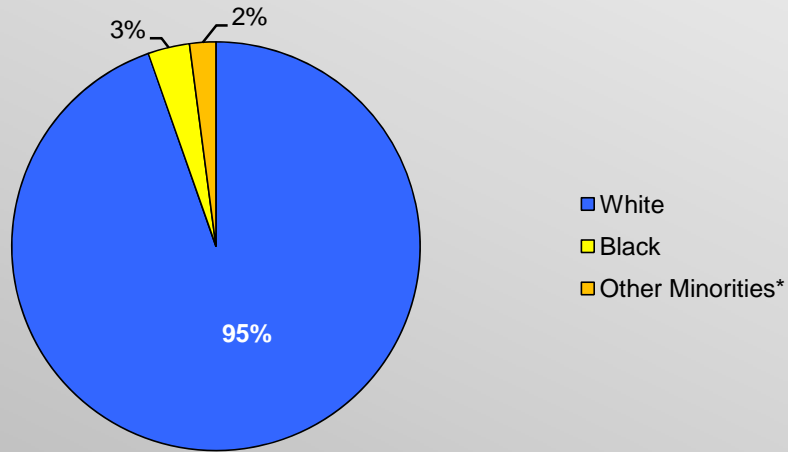
