Directions: The checklist below provides steps that MSU students may need to complete before their financial aid can be disbursed for the upcoming Fall semester.

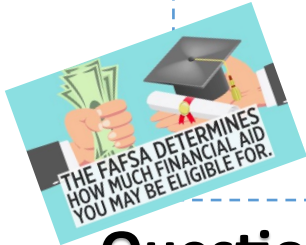
Question # 1

Have you completed your 2021-2022 FAFSA?

In order to apply for federal aid, you must register for an FSA ID and complete your 2021/2022 FAFSA (this is your financial aid application) at studentaid.gov. Remember to complete your FAFSA every year as close to October 1st as possible.



Question # 2

Were you selected for a process known as Verification?

Students who have been selected for Verification cannot be awarded their financial aid until they have been verified. Visit KHEAAVerify.com in order to obtain the necessary steps for the completion of the Verification process.

Question # 3

Have you received a financial aid offer letter from MSU?

After submitting your FAFSA and/or completing the Verification process, you must monitor your [MyMoreheadState](#) account (when activated). Your financial aid may be adjusted based on your verification. Students are notified via email when changes made to your financial aid.

Question # 4

Have you reviewed your financial aid offer letter and accepted your financial aid awards?

In order to view, accept, or decline your financial aid, you must log in to your [MyMoreheadState](#) account. Then you must select *Self-Service* and then *Financial Aid*, and select the appropriate aid year from the drop-down menu.

Don't forget to check your current billing information on your [MyMoreheadstateaccount](#), under *Student Finance* on Self-Service. Make sure you select the current term.

It is important that you accept your *Financial Responsibility Agreement*. Select "Financial Agreement" from the Helpful Links menu, select the appropriate term, then click **SUBMIT**. Read the agreement, then select "Accept" and click **SUBMIT**.

Question # 5

Is this your first time borrowing federal student loans?

If you have accepted your federal student loans and are a first-time loan borrower, you will also need to visit [Studentloans.gov](#), and then complete your [Entrance Counseling](#) and e-sign your [Master Promissory Note \(MPN\)](#). Even if you have already accepted your loans on your Financial Aid self-service account, your federal student loans will not disburse until these two tasks have been completed.

Is your fall and spring financial aid enough to cover each semester's cost?
