

ENTRANCE COUNSELING

If you have not previously received a Direct Loan or Federal Family Education Loan (FFEL), the Federal Government requires you to complete entrance counseling to ensure that you understand the responsibilities and obligations you are assuming.

Entrance Counseling must be completed by the student in order to receive federal direct loans.

To complete Entrance Counseling as an undergraduate student or graduate/professional student, you will need to do the following:

Log in to www.studentaid.gov using your personal FSA ID.

If you are a new user or have forgotten your FSA ID go to <https://fsaid.ed.gov>.

Select ENTRANCE COUNSELING, then enter the name(s) of the school(s) you wish to notify of your counseling completion.
