

1. Upon arrival at MSU, report to the Office of International Student Services (OISS) for SEVIS registration and an orientation session.
2. At the beginning of each semester report to OISS to be registered in SEVIS *within 10 days of the start of the semester.*
3. Maintain & be able to provide a valid Passport.
4. Maintain & be able to provide a valid DS-2019 form.
5. Maintain & be able to provide a valid I-94 marked D/S.
 - a. These can be readily retrieved online from <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/I94/#/home>
6. Engage in only those activities permitted under your program and category.
 - a. For example: a student is expected to maintain a full-time course of study and to study only at the university listed on their DS-2019.
7. Apply for extensions and transfers in a timely manner. Failure to apply for an extension in a timely manner may result in the termination of your status. You must first obtain permission from your program sponsor for an extension before applying for one to OISS.
8. Refrain from any unauthorized employment. Unauthorized employment is a violation of your program status and may subject you to termination.
9. Maintain the required health insurance coverage.
10. Report any change of address to OISS within 10 days.
