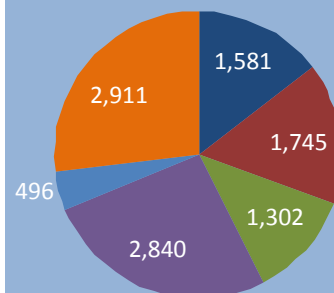

Enrollment Quick Facts

- 487 new transfer students (including 10 Black, Non-Hispanics). 316 transferred from KCTCS.
- 6,134 enrolled from the 22-county service region.
- 3,505 enrolled from other Kentucky counties.
- 1,040 enrolled from 41 other states.
- 196 enrolled from 31 foreign countries.
- 52 Black, Non-Hispanics were among the 1,461 first-time freshmen.
- 65% First-Time Freshman retention rate from Fall 2014 to Fall 2015 (58% for under-represented minorities).
- 3,143 students in MSU residence halls and apartments.
