



Department Specific Immunization Requirements MSU Imaging Science Department

Please use this information as a reference for required vaccinations required for MSU Imaging Science. This information is based on required vaccinations for health care providers as recommended by the Center for Disease Control (CDC).

- **Hepatitis B (series of 3 injections)**
 - #1- on day of injection
 - #2-28 days or more after first injection
 - #3-4-6 months after second injection
- *****VACCINATIONS SERIES ARE NOT TO BE STARTED OVER IF TOO LONG BETWEEN INJECTIONS (e.g. started hepatitis B #1 on March 1, 2011; not getting #2 until present-will start with #2 on Feb 1, 2012 and can get #3 injection, 4-6 months after second injection)**
- **Tdap**
 - One time dose is necessary and Td (tetanus booster) will occur every 10 years after.
 - ****Td does not count for this vaccination; if Td is given, a Tdap will still be necessary***
- **Varicella**
 - If positive chicken pox disease, need to document approximate month and year
 - If no history of chicken pox—need 2 varicella vaccines, at least 28 days apart
- **MMR**
 - 2 documented MMR vaccines
- **PPD/TB Skin Test**
 - 2-step required if first ever test or if greater than 1 year since last TB test
 - First TB test given/return for reading in 2- 3 days; a second TB test is given 10-14 days after first/return for reading in 2-3 days
 - One TB Skin Test will be required once every year when in health care
- **INFLUENZA/Flu**
 - RECOMMENDED FOR IMAGING SCIENCE AND MAY BE REQUIRED BASED ON CLINICAL SITE ROTATION

REMEMBER TO PROVIDE COPY OF CERTIFIED IMMUNIZATION RECORD TO COUNSELING & HEALTH SERVICES!!! YOU WILL NOT BE VERIFIED AS COMPLIANT UNTIL THIS IS REVIEWED BY C&HS STAFF. REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR THIS DOCUMENT CAN BE FOUND ON COUNSELING & HEALTH SERVICES WEBSITE
