All Morehead State University students traveling abroad for academic purposes are eligible to apply for international insurance available through the Office of Risk Management / Environmental Health and Safety. Medical insurance purchased fulfills minimum basic requirements for accidents, sickness, accidental death or dismemberment, emergency evacuation and repatriation.

Procedure For Students Participating In Sponsored Job Related Study Abroad Or Cultural Enrichment Programs:

Students who are participating in a MSU-sponsored study abroad or cultural enrichment program are eligible for their department to purchase supplemental international medical insurance.

The Office of Risk Management / Environmental Health and Safety will verify eligibility for supplemental coverages. The request for payment will be initiated upon successful enrollment and review of travel itinerary.

1. No less than three (3) weeks prior to the scheduled departure date, the student will provide to the Office Risk Management/ Environmental Health and Safety the following:
 - a. Completed application form.
 - b. Copy of itinerary.
 - c. Proof of payment for the application fee by the department or individual.
2. Successful enrollment verification will be provided by the Office of Risk Management / Environmental Health and Safety to all participating student members.
