Per PG-64, tobacco is defined as all tobacco-derived or containing products, including but not limited to cigarettes (clove, bidis, kreteks), cigars and cigarillos, hookah-smoked products, and oral tobacco (spit and spit-less, smokeless, chew, snuff) and those devices/products giving the appearance of tobacco use such as electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes) and vaping devices.

Per PG-64, exceptions to the University Tobacco Use Policy are only allowed in designated outside smoking areas approved by the MSU President. Approved smoking areas will be clearly marked with signage and be equipped with appropriate containers for disposal of ash, butts and other waste from tobacco use.

The designated outside smoking areas allowed by this policy are:

- 1) West end of campus - The concreted area in the yard across Second Street from Lappin Hall at the corner of Second Street and Battson-Oates
- 2) Behind Third Street Eats - The fenced area directly behind Third Street Eats
- 3) East-central area of campus - The designated area next to the loading docks at Alumni Tower

It is in these areas only that tobacco use will be permitted.
