OUR PURPOSE

The Morehead State University Summer Arts Academy exists to nurture students' development in the arts in a setting which allows interaction with expert faculty and the opportunity to work with other students who share specific interest in music, theatre, art and design, and writing and media. All students will select a course of study appropriate to their individual medium, but all will receive the same opportunities.

THE ACADEMY

The Academy consists of six full days of activities, including individual and group instruction in your chosen area (music, theatre, art and design, and writing and media). Recreational activities will include an art hop night, movie night, bowling night and performances/presentations by the Morehead State University Summer Arts Academy faculty.

REPRESENTED AREAS:

- **ART & DESIGN:** Ceramics, Digital Art, Photography, Printmaking and Art Activism
- **MUSIC:** Group lessons and masterclasses will be given during the designated times each day. Students will learn specific techniques to take with them which will improve their individual musicianship. The following areas are offered: Bass, Bassoon, Clarinet, Flute, Oboe, Percussion, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Tuba/Euphonium and Voice.
Music students will also choose two electives: Choir, Conducting, Eurhythmics, Jazz Improvisation or Music Technology.
- **THEATRE:** A study of acting from both the aesthetic and practical viewpoints. Through fundamental techniques associated with the acting process, students will discover methodologies that will prove to be beneficial tools in the development of their craft.
- **WRITING AND MEDIA:** Explorations in creative writing and convergent media will lead to individual multi-genre passion projects. Students who enroll in Writing and Media will have the unique opportunity to explore a variety of media to tell their story and share it with an authentic audience.
