The MSU Alumni Board provides opportunities for enthusiastic alumni to become more engaged with the University and to serve its needs. The Board supports the strategic goals of the Alumni Relations and Development Office to increase alumni involvement with the University by leveraging networks and promoting engagement opportunities.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Attend three meetings per year, generally held in February, May and September.
- Serve an initial term of three years, which is renewable for an additional three year term upon the recommendation of the Board.
- Serve as an ambassador for MSU and the Alumni Relations and Development Office, which may include:
 - Meeting with fellow alumni.
 - Attending local and on campus events.
 - Speaking to current students in a classroom setting.
 - Working with current students in a mentoring/networking capacity.
 - Speaking with prospective students.
- Support the development efforts of the MSU Foundation and University Advancement when appropriate
- Attend and help host various events hosted by the MSU Alumni Association (Homecoming, winter Alumni Day), as well as campus-wide functions.
- Make an annual contribution to be an active member of the Alumni Association. There is an expectation of 100% participation.
- Actively participate in the Alumni Board strategic planning process to establish, support and promote the mission, vision, goals and objectives of the Alumni Association and the University.
- Be actively engaged during Board meetings, providing feedback and willingly accepting tasks that are needed to complete Board goals.
- Engage other alumni, seeking their feedback on their student and alumni experiences and learning about their continued alumni needs.
- Remain knowledgeable about University and Alumni Association programs and services.
- Provide timely responses to Alumni Association requests and notices.
- Serve as a resource to the Alumni Relations and Development office in identifying potential Board members, award nominees and other alumni volunteers based on current needs and priorities.
- Serve on at least one committee of the Board.
