

# Early Graduate School Admission Checklist



## Criteria for Admission to the Early Graduate School Program

Student has completed at least 90 undergraduate semester hours.

Student possesses a minimum cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher.

*\*Some programs have additional requirements (refer to the Graduate Catalog for details).*

*\*\*The following programs are not eligible for Early Graduate School admission: Master of Arts in Teaching, Master of Arts in Education, and the Master of Science in Clinical Psychology.*

## The Admission Process

- Review the requirements for the specific program you are applying to (refer to the Graduate Catalog). Start getting the required application materials together. If you have questions, please contact your academic advisor or the Graduate School.
- Discuss with your academic advisor the graduate courses you should take, or contact a staff member in the Graduate School to schedule an advising session. You will need this information for the Early Graduate School program application.
- For priority consideration, complete and submit both of the following by March 15th (for the fall) or October 15th (for the spring):
  - (1) the Early Graduate School program application, and
  - (2) the Graduate School application. *\*Please note: submit all required graduate admission materials by priority deadlines.*
- After all required materials have been received, your application will be reviewed by the program department. A decision about your admission will be emailed to your Morehead State email address. *\*Please Note: A program admission decision cannot be made until **ALL** required admission materials are received and reviewed. Materials required for admission vary by program. Please refer to the Graduate Catalog for details about your program or contact the Graduate School for more information.*
- Once admitted to the specific graduate program, a representative from the Graduate School will admit you to the Early Graduate School and will enroll you in the graduate courses requested on your Early Graduate School program application. If, for any reason, you are unable to be enrolled in a requested course (i.e., course is full or requires prerequisite), this will be noted on your acceptance letter. Discuss any changes or scheduling concerns with your academic advisor or contact a staff member in the Graduate School. *\*Note: As an Early Graduate School student, your total course load cannot exceed 15 hours during a semester.*
- After you are registered for your graduate courses, contact the Office of Accounting & Financial Services at 606-783-2019 to make sure that your charges reflect undergraduate tuition rates for your graduate courses. Let them know that you have been admitted to the Early Graduate School program. You should also contact the Office of Financial Aid at 606-783-2011 to see if any changes may occur.

## After you are admitted:

- In order to continue in the Early Graduate School program, you must continue to meet the following criteria:
  - maintain a cumulative **undergraduate** GPA of at least 3.0 and a **graduate** GPA of at least 3.0.
- For each subsequent semester(s), you will need to complete an Early Graduate School program application and submit it to the Graduate School during Advanced Registration. The courses you request should be discussed with your academic advisor prior to submission to the Graduate School. *\*Please note: You will **NOT** need to complete another Graduate School application.*
