

Using your PNC Chip and PIN Card is Easy!

- 1 Insert your card into the chip reader with the chip facing up.



- 2 Leave your card in the terminal and follow any prompts on the screen.



- 3 Remove card when prompted, and take your receipt. You may also be asked to provide a signature.

Information about your PNC Chip and PIN Card



A chip card is a credit card that has an encrypted microchip embedded on the front of the plastic to help prevent card cloning. Your chip card also has a four-digit PIN for added security.

Information about Your PIN

Your PIN will be mailed separately to you for security purposes. It will be important to memorize the PIN for your chip card.

If You Forget Your PIN

Contact customer service (1-800-685-4039) and choose option 3 from the menu to select a new PIN.

When Making Purchases

You may not be prompted for your PIN every time you use your chip card at a chip-enabled merchant terminal. Your chip card still has a magnetic stripe on the back. If the merchant does not have a chip-enabled merchant terminal, you can swipe the card to complete the transaction.
