

APPLICATION FOR FRESHMAN ART & DESIGN SCHOLARSHIPS DEPARTMENT OF ART & DESIGN - MOREHEAD STATE UNIVERSITY

The Department of Art and Design offers Art & Design Leadership Scholarships for entering freshman art majors in the amount of \$500, applied \$250 per semester. The Department also offers, for residents of Kentucky, the **W. Paul and Lucille Caudill Little Scholarship for Study of the Arts at Morehead State University** that awards up to \$7,000 per year. Both are renewable for up to four years for an art major in good academic standing.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must first apply to Morehead State University by completing the Admission and Scholarship Application (www.moreheadstate.edu/apply). In addition to the application, you need to send your 7-semester high school transcript and ACT or SAT scores to Enrollment Services, 121 East Second ST, Morehead, KY 40351.

Your completed Undergraduate Admission and support materials must be received by March 1, 2019, to best compete for these attractive scholarships. Scholarship applications require the following:

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PORTFOLIO/MATERIALS (Required for all Art & Design Scholarships):

1. A portfolio of 8 to 10 of your art works done within the last 2 years. Include examples of more than one medium. Suggested media: Drawing, Ceramics, Sculpture, Painting, Photography, Printmaking and/or Computer Art (Digital portfolios showing any of the listed media can be submitted by March 13, 2019. They must include a list of art works and media).
2. Two letters of recommendation, one of which should be from an art teacher or another teacher familiar with your work.
3. A written statement of your reasons for wanting to major in art at Morehead State University. Use a separate sheet of paper and attach it to this form.
4. A High School transcript.
5. This completed application form.

Portfolio Review Day: Portfolios containing original work are reviewed during High School Art Day on March 13, 2019. Please bring this Scholarship Application Information form, your art portfolio, two letters of recommendation, your written statement and a copy of your high school transcript to your portfolio review. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
