The Balanced Man Program of Sigma Phi Epsilon places an emphasis on pursuing the ideals of a Sound Mind and Sound Body. Members focus on time management skills, leadership skills and developing a sense of civility. Our brothers used these attributes to achieve the highest grades for a fraternity on Morehead's campus nine semesters in a row. Ultimately, members develop professional skills useful for life after graduation.

The Kentucky Zeta Chapter has exemplified these characteristics on Morehead's campus by achieving the highest-grade point average among Greek men for the last five semesters, receiving various community service awards such as the best community service project, and having Brothers represent MSU as Homecoming King for a number of years. SigEp was recognized as fraternity of the year and then as Greek organization of the Year. The aforementioned accolades are only a few of the astounding traits held by the men of Sigma Phi Epsilon. The Kentucky Zeta Chapter also was awarded the Buchanan Cup for 2017. This is the highest honor a Sigma Phi Epsilon chapter can receive. It is only awarded through the embodiment of our principles.
