Electronic Health Records

Privacy Practices

Morehead State University Counseling and Health Services take reasonable steps to limit the use or disclosure of your health information to the minimum necessary to accomplish the intended purpose. Limited health information may be disclosed for the purposes of treatment, payment for care or health care operations. We also may remove identifying information to use health care data for statistical purposes such as (but not limited to) research, advertising or marketing. If necessary, we may disclose information to prevent or reduce the risk of a serious or imminent threat to the health or safety of an individual or the general public. We may disclose limited information to law enforcement as necessary for the purposes of individual or public protection. We may also disclose information to others as required by court or administrative order, or in response to a valid summons or subpoena.

We have instituted security measures that are reasonable and appropriate to protect personal information, in any form, from unauthorized access, disclosure, or use. Electronic health care records are stored on local servers in an isolated and secure location. Policies and procedures are in place, subject to periodic review, to ensure that your health information privacy is maintained. Security measures that we use include computer safeguards, secured files, and employee security training.

The practices described in this notice only apply to Counseling and Health Services and its service providers. These practices may not apply to any other organizations, links, websites, programs, or applications that may be available through Morehead State University.
