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Awards Criteria

For the purposes of this program, “intern” includes any experiential education placement: student teaching, clinicals, practicums, internships, and cooperative education.

Faculty who provided credit for students’ experiential education **during 2018 (spring ‘18, summer ‘18, fall ‘18 semesters)**.

Employers, students, deans, department chairs and faculty may submit nominations. The criteria are:

- Devotes extra effort or resources to secure experiential activities for students
- Devotes extra effort or resources to prepare students for an experiential activity
- Works with employers to ensure class instruction and site experience for students are integrated and complementary
- Demonstrates commitment to student success, as described on the nomination form

Employers who provided sites for students’ experiential education at any point **during 2018** are eligible. Students, faculty and staff who have interacted with the nominated employer in relation to a student internship, may submit nominations.

The criteria are:

- Devotes effort and resources to ensure students receive not only industry-specific skills, but transferable skills as well
- Works with MSU faculty to ensure class instruction and site experience for students are integrated and complementary
- Acts as a mentor in providing training and regular feedback
- Demonstrates a genuine concern for the advancement of the student as a professional

Students who have participated in experiential education (internships, cooperative education, student teaching, practicums or clinicals), **during 2018 (spring ‘18, summer ‘18, fall ‘18 semesters) are eligible**. Employers, as well as MSU faculty and staff who have interacted with this person in relation to an internship, may submit nominations. The criteria are:

- Superior work ethic demonstrated at the employment site
- Adaptability when confronting new/unusual situations
- Thoroughness and timeliness of work
- Superior quality and quantity of work, as reported on the nomination form
