Curricular practical training (CPT), employment which is an integral part of an established curriculum, is available to F-1 students who have been lawfully enrolled on a full-time basis for a least nine consecutive months. To be considered CPT, the work must not only be related to the major field of study but must also be an integral part of studies. **CPT is not meant to be a convenient employment opportunity nor is it meant to be a device to save optional practical training (the other practical training type) months. CPT must have valid purpose in the student's program of study.**

There are two types of curricular practical training: (1) required part of program-program requires employment in the field of study to graduate and (2) optional part of program-training opportunity which is credit bearing and an important and integral part of the academic program. Very few programs at Morehead State University require employment in the field of study to graduate, so the optional part of curricular practical training may serve the student's needs.
