## Requirements for Students on Academic Probation Spring 2024

Make sure to complete the online Academic Recovery Orientation workshop. Failure to complete will adversely affect your participation in the Academic Recovery Program.

## During the Spring 2024 semester, you MUST:

<u>Participate in the Academic Recovery Program as required by the probation quidelines for scholastic standing.</u>

NO ACTION IS NEEDED FOR THE ACADEMIC RECOVERY PROGRAM UNTIL THE FALL SEMESTER BEGINS.

## The following requirements are the components of the Academic Recovery Program:

- 1. The first step is to visit the Academic Probation website to learn more information about the Academic Recovery Program for Spring 2024 <a href="https://www.moreheadstate.edu/probation">www.moreheadstate.edu/probation</a>.
- 2. Complete the online **Academic Recovery Workshop** offered in January 16-January 26, 2024. *Students must complete the required online workshop and quiz by no later than <u>January 26, 2024.</u>*
- 3. Meet at least <u>THREE</u> times per semester with your assigned <u>Peer Coach</u>. Your first meeting with a Peer Coach should be scheduled after completion of the online workshop. Students should follow the steps outlined in Blackboard after completing the Workshop and quiz to schedule the first peer coaching appointment. Peer coaching appointments can be completed face-to-face, by telephone, or virtually using WebEx video conferencing.
- 4. Complete an **Action Plan** (<u>to be completed and signed by the student and reviewed by the academic advisor and peer coach</u>). Students must have the Action Plan completed and submitted by no later Friday, January 26, 2024.
- 5. Complete the Mid-Semester Success Module (Blackboard Module) February 27-March 15, 2024
- 6. Weekly documented study hours and/or tutoring sessions are strongly encouraged.
- 7. Progress reports may be required depending upon ARP staff/advisor/faculty recommendations.

Students are strongly encouraged to develop a structured study schedule. Below are the hours of operation for the various study/tutoring locations across campus for Fall 2023.

- Tutoring and Learning Center in Allie Young Hall 220; Hours: M-F 8:00am 4:30pm
- Tutoring and Learning Center in the Library (TLC follows designated Library hours\*) when in-person appointments are conducted.
